Originally Hebrew had only the aleph-bet letters at left; there were no vowels, except sometimes vav and yod functioned as vowels, much as the letter Y does in English.

In the 5th to 10th centuries CE, scholars known as Masoretes added vowel markings ("pointing") to help readers know how to pronounce the words. Most Hebrew Bibles today include the vowel pointing.

Here are some common Hebrew names. Notice the vowel points, but don't worry about memorizing them. Concentrate on the aleph-bet.
